

Sub: Regarding the change of coffee shop (A3) to Hot take away (A5)

I would like to raise an issue regarding the above mentioned reference.

The business we have started quite recently selling chicken, fish, burgers & chips in 8 Parkhouse court in Hatfield. If the coffee shop would be converted to hot take away which is going to be Kebab shop, then this will also include the same menu what we do in our business shop.
