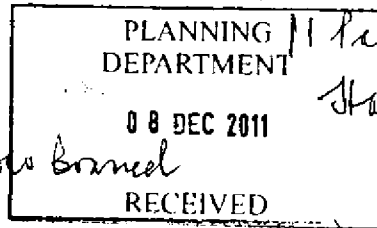

I want to protest against this plan on the grounds, as I understand it, that these shops are to be demolished before replacement shop premises are made available in Salisbury Square. The present plan only provides for new shop premises some two or three years after present shops are demolished. These are in the parade, including a Sausage, a Hardware Shop and a Book & Butter store. If the plans are carried out these businesses will suffer irreparable loss of their trade and goodwill. All these businesses are of great value to residents of Old Halfield. You will appreciate that in Salisbury there is a great amount of shopping and...

and ² electrical installation to the Wessing machines
and spin wheels. A move to new premises, even
if available would be costly. No doubt the
same applies to the Halkesing Salzwitz its
basins and electrics.

I understand there is only one other
Laundrette in Hatfield at a considerable distance
from Old Hatfield and one in Welwyn Garden City
Mr. A S Kari has built up considerable goodwill
locally and feels and returns wishes for
disabled people like myself. I would request
you consider refusing the present application
altogether or at least until the replacement shop
premises have been erected in Salisbury Square.
The present planning application do not appear to
have been made in the right sequence. New
premises should be available and reserved for
present lessees of the shops at the time present
tenancy is terminated. We will be without shop for 2 (53
