Decision
Notice is given under article 16 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2010 that the Hertfordshire County Council as Highway Authority does not wish to restrict the grant of permission subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The intensity of illumination shall be controlled at a level that is within the limit recommended by the Institution of Lighting Professionals in TR5 Brightness of Illuminated Advertisements(2001)

Reason: So that drivers of vehicles along the adjacent highways are not dazzled or distracted, leading to interference to the free and safe flow of traffic along the highway.

COMMENTS: Given the proposal involves the installation of internally illuminated signs the above recommended conditions will ensure that drivers of vehicles along the adjacent public highway are not dazzled or distracted, prejudicial to highway safety Hertfordshire County Council has no other highway issues as a result of this proposal.
