Design and Access Statement

We note the details provided in this document showing the provision of:

- a. An increased number of bedrooms from 20 to 26.
- b. Confirmation that bedrooms must be at least 12.5m² in size with an attached bathroom at least 3.5 m² in size.
- c. To increase the number of car parking spaces to 16 with paved surroundings and approaches with 4 designated disabled parking bays.

We are unable to find a mention of Part M. Will the buildings meet these guidelines?

We note the details provided by this drawing showing there is stepped entry at all doors.
This is not appropriate for wheelchairs and limited/impaired mobility persons and should in our opinion be changed to level entry especially as some, if not all, may double as fire exits.

Drawing no EL/2012/008 – PROPOSED ELEVATIONS - NORTH EAST and WEST We note the details provided by this drawing showing there is stepped entry at all doors. This is not appropriate for wheelchairs and limited/impaired mobility persons and should in our opinion be changed to level entry especially as some, if not all, may double as fire exits.

Drawing no EL/2012/005 – PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLANS
We note the pedestrian access ramp at the principal front door. We also note the location of the public toilets in the main building, which appear to be wheelchair accessible. Do they fully comply with Part M guidelines?

Having asked that question can you advise if there is table service in the dining room or does need collecting from the kitchen area as the step is a potential access hazard. Furthermore, the toilet in the kitchen area appears to be wheelchair accessible. Please confirm the situation.

We note the details provided by this drawing. Could you confirm if the pa
