1. Database and ecological evaluation

The LRC database does not hold any biological records (habitats or species) for 12 Ramsey Close or the immediate surrounding area. From the documents supplied and aerial photographs we assess the dwelling proposed for conversion and the garage proposed for demolition as being suboptimal as bat roost sites and we consider that it would be unreasonable for the LPA to require a bat assessment survey to be submitted in support of this application.
