You have an option to have either one 180 litre bin per property for refuse which will be emptied fortnightly on the existing ARRC contract, or two larger 360 litre bins to be shared. In addition we can provide Blue lidded dry recycling bins for glass, cans and plastics. These are 240 or 360 litre bins which we could offer to share between the flats. please bear in mind that if the recycling bins become contaminated we will not empty them and the residents or mgt Co would have to pay to empty them. You may therefore wish to consider whether you wish to offer recycling facilities at all. As the development is less than 10 dwelling bins are provided FOC
