DISCUSSION: I have visited 5 Hooks Lane regarding the above application to carry out works to the trees. Having spoken to the resident Mr Freshwater, I was able to clarify the works requested they are as follows:

Crown reduce both T7 and T9 by up to 20% balancing trees where required

T8 prune branch growing towards house

An e-mail correspondence between Mr Freshwater and myself has been attached to the TPO folder.

The work requested is good arboricultural practise and will reduce the spread of the trees in the small rear garden whilst having little effect on the amenity value of the trees. I therefore have no objections with application being approved.
