**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:** Removal of two main limbs down to main union from oak tree (T3) covered by TPO 3 to reduce the risk of failure over road and leave main stem for standing habitat.

### PARISH COUNCIL COMMENTS:

As principle always object to remove or crown trees covered by TPO, also policy of Parish Council to accept recommendations of arborologist.

## **REPRESENTATIONS:**

The application was not advertised.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The application form applies to carry out works to seven trees and one group of trees. Only one tree is actually within a protected area, T3.

T3 is a mature oak which died some years ago and has been left for ecology reasons. It stands within a woodland but adjacent to a busy driveway. As the tree decays it poses an increasing risk to any persons or property which pass below the tree. The proposed works strike a balance between safety and retaining a diverse habitat.

As T3 is completely dead it is not currently protected by TPO legislation.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Oak Tree (T3) is completely dead and is not protected by Tree Preservation Order legislation. Permission is therefore not required for the works.
