The propsoal would allow for better quality living conditions than that afforded by a standard HMO. The facilities provided would provide greater independence to tenants whilst retaining elements of communal living. The property would retain communal kitchen areas, living areas and clothes washing facilities.

The numberof tenants would not have a materially greater impact on neighbouring occupiers than a 6-bedroom HMO.
