RECOMMENDATION

The proposal **fails to comply** with Schedule 2, Part 1, Class A of The Town and Country (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended by The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2013 for the following reason:

The proposed development would extend beyond the rear wall of the original dwellinghouse by up 7.4 metres due to the proposed extension being attached to the existing detached garage. The dwelling is a terraced property which is permitted an extension only up to 6 metres in depth.
