4. The signs hereby given consent shall be permanently removed from the site before the expiry of a period of five years beginning at the date of this consent, unless the Local Planning Authority has given prior written approval for their retention.

REASON

To limit the period of display of this prominent signage in the interests of visual amenity.

NOTES

- 1. Advertisements may continue to be displayed after the expiry of the permitted period, subject to the power of the Local Planning Authority to serve notice under Regulation 16.
- 2. Under paragraph 6(4) of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1989, before any advertisement is displayed the permission of the owner of the land or building on which the advertisement is to be displayed must be obtained.
