Comments	<input type="text" value="I wish to object to the proposal to develop the site, it is within the Green Belt and understand the National Planning Policy Framework does not allow such buildings. The B156 is already a very busy 'B' road and is the only road into Cuffley from Enfield and surrounding areas. It is usually very busy during rush hours and often grinds to a halt when there is an accident on the M25. Any development will add to the road useage and cause further obstructions with cars entering and leaving the proposed site. Cuffley is a small village with limited amenities and any further housing will impact heavily, especially on schooling. It is therefore imperative that no further housing developments are allowed and the green belt preserved for the reasons it was desiged for. I am not against new housing, although feel it should be within areas with adequate infrastructure and facilities and does not cause detriment to small villages."/>
