Comments	<input type="text" value="This objection is in response to the council letter dated 5/1/21. Our view is that 8 Hill Rise has breached planning because it is far too large and is not in character with the surrounding properties in the road. No other property near No.8 is three storey, and anyway it has a significantly higher ridge level than was originally given approval for. This has meant that we can see the top of the building from our garden interrupting the skyline. The windows are really obtrusive. Windows to properties each side and opposite No.8 are white cottage style as it most of the street. No.8 has windows with huge panes of glass with black aluminium frames. The approved windows were upvc sash windows which would have broken up the window lines. In our opinion the house looks disproportionately large and is not in keeping with the rest of the properties in Hill Rise."/>
