It doesn't meet the criteria to justify exceptional circumstances, protect openness, prevent urban sprawl, nor does it prevent encroachment of the countryside. The Green Belt must be preserved and protected for future generations. These high harm developments must be refused. Northaw's residents are dependent on the towns of Cuffley/Potters Bar for its amenities & facilities. As such Northaw isn't sustainable as the residents all rely on their cars to make such journeys.
