The back garden at 55 Longcroft Lane has a large number of trees which are densely planted. The Copper Beech				

(1) specifically has not been maintained and is now dwarfing our and our neighbours' houses. Due to it's size we have concerns that in high winds branches will break and fall, damaging nearby properties and potentially injuring

people for which we would be liable. The Copper Beech (1) has a constant shadow that blocks natural light

reducing the amenity value of the surrounds, and its roots are a trip hazard.

7. Identification Of Tree(s) And Description Of Works continued				
We want to allow more sunshine to reach the garden areas to improve the growth of grass and other plants. At present the many trees have prevented this and caused the soil to become exhausted of nutrients.				
Most of the existing trees are largely unseen by passers by in Longcroft Lane or from the main railway line so there is little loss of amenity to others and a significant gain to those living at the property and neighbours. There is a Laburnum tree which has high toxicity levels in all parts, which again is a concern with our young children.				
To cover all the concerns above we looking to remove the following trees: Copper Beech (1), Silver Birch (3), Oak (4), Silver Birch (5), Conifer (6), Laburnum (7), Fir (10), Silver Birch (11)				
The trees to be removed have little amenity value especially as the site is overgrown by numerous trees allowed to grow over many years due to lack of control. Another very large tree is in 53 Longcroft next to the Copper Beech (1) and also there are a few large trees growing near the rear boundary on probable Council property at the rear of the public car park, as well as a few large trees at the back of 57 Longcroft Lane.				
We are looking to have more open space for our children (and their friends) to play safely and also to teach them about growing vegetables and flowers where there will now be space to do so. We are also considering growing right at the very back of the garden some taller evergreen bushes to help screen the noise of trains.
