ARCHAEOLOGICAL IMPLICATIONS

Thank you for consulting me on the above application.

The proposed site plan submitted with this application shows that geotextile membrane will be laid over existing ground levels, and the ground built up from there. Therefore, despite the high likelihood of archaeological features being present, it is unlikely that any such features would be disturbed by the proposed development.

In this instance, therefore, I consider that the development is unlikely to have an impact on heritage assets of archaeological interest, and I have no comment to make upon the proposal.
