Thank you for your letter of 8 February 2016 and for consulting Hertfordshire Ecology on the amendments to this application.

The proposed amendments are of little consequence in ecological terms. Circumstances remain the same; the existing ecological report remains valid and confirms that the site supports little intrinsic ecological interest. There are few ecological constraints and there is no reason to change our opinion of 'no objection' as expressed in our previous letter of 26 January 2016.

I will take this opportunity to advise that a cautious approach to demolition is pursued as the ecological report did find evidence of nesting birds. In general terms, all wild birds, their nests and eggs are protected by law, and it is an offence to kill, injure or disturb a wild bird, and take, or damage their nest or eggs. Therefore, to reduce the likelihood of harm arising and of an offence being committed, I recommend that the following *Informative* is added to any consent:

"In order to protect breeding birds, their nests, eggs and young, demolition activities should <u>only</u> be carried out during the period October to February. If this is not possible then a pre-development (<u>same-day</u>) search of the area should be made by a suitably experienced ecologist. If active nests are found, then clearance work must be delayed until the juvenile birds have left the nest and are fully independent or
