Thank you for consulting us on the above planning application for the erection of a second floor extension to existing hotel, including a further 19 bedroom and gymnasium (renewal of S6/2013/2174/MS).

After reviewing the information submitted by the applicant in support to the planning application the Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) does not object to this planning application. The LLFA decision is based on the fact that the will be no increase on the footprint of the development. We have also considered the letter submitted by the applicant, FRA Justification II, where it states that after communication with the LPA a flood risk assessment is no needed for this planning application.

However, we advise that the surrounding area of this development has the potential for flooding issues. Therefore considering HCC SuDS Policy 14, we would advise the LPA to seek additional information, namely how the applicant proposes to manage the surface water presently and if any changes to the current situation are proposed by the applicant.
