Comments	<input type="text" value="Planning application form (section 6 - Trees) asks the applicant to declare any trees that are within falling distance of the development. The applicant has declared none, either on the application form nor on the drawings. As a neighbour who looks onto the site, we are aware of 4 trees, ranging from circa 12m to 16m high on the rear boundary to 83 Bramble Road. These can be clearly seen from satellite imagery available to the public on the internet. We would expect that the application information submitted to date should be withdrawn and updated to include the presence of the trees, particularly from a biodiversity perspective and that our local area falls within the Watling Chase Community Forest initiative."/>
