- (1) If the applicant wishes to have an explanation of the reasons for this decision it will be given on request and a meeting arranged if necessary.
- (2) Advertisements may continue to be displayed after the expiry of the permitted period, subject to the power of the Local Planning Authority to serve notice under Regulation 16.
- (3) If the applicant is aggrieved by the decision of the local planning authority to grant consubject to conditions he may by notice served within one month of receipt of this notice appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment in accordance with Regulation 22 the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations, 1969. The Secretary of State is not, having regard to the provisions of those Regulations, required to entertain such an appeal if it appears to him that Consent for the display of advertisements could not have been granted by the local planning authority otherwise than subject to the conditions imposed by them. The Secretary of State, however, has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a Notice of Appeal.
- (4) In certain circumstances a claim may be made against the local planning authority for compensation where as a result of refusal of consent or its grant subject to conditions it is necessary for works of removal to be carried out. The circumstances in which such compensation is payable are set out in Section 176 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.
- (5) Under paragraph 6(4) of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements)
 Regulations, 1969, before any advertisement is displayed the permission of the owner of the land or building on which the advertisement is to be displayed must be obtained.
