You can see there is lots of included bark and is also starting to show plenty of rot at the base of the tree. They are very keen to resolve this as soon as possible as they don't want anything to damage their new sports facility. This tree is amongst 8 other large Oak trees. Any tree planted i feel would struggle to compete.
