e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

T1 - Ash tree (Fraxinus) re-pollard. The all round Pollard of one Ash tree roughly 15FT in height and roughly 9FT on all lateral branches back to old Pollard points. The tree in question is just in the garden boundary from woods. The canopy of the Ash tree has got so tall that if the tree were to fall it would most certainly cause damage to the house if it fell that way, the trees canopy has started to grow all on one side due to the tree not getting any light at the rear due to the quantity of trees behind blocking the light. upon observation at the base of the tree the soil is at two different levels, with the soil level at the rear of the tree being roughly 1ft lower than the soil level at the front of the tree mean if the tree were to even fall it would most likely fall towards the house, pollarding the tree to saver height and taking the weight out of the tree is going to take most of the risk away.
