Planning Statement

This Waste Management Planning Statement accompanies the planning application at Brookmans Park Teleport, Great North Road, Brookmans Park, Hatfield AL9 6NE.

The proposed development is to enable Inmarsat to relocate its research and development activities to part of Brookmans Park Teleport.

Estate Waste Facilities

Waste collection on site is managed by Arqiva. The estate provides 4 x 1100 litre Euro General waste containers and 3 x 1100 Euro DMR waste containers for tenant use. All are located in the central estate waste compound and are collected on a weekly basis. There is also 1 x WEEE container plus 1 x wood skip available with collection on an ad-hoc basis.

Inmarsat Waste Requirements

Small amounts of waste will be produced from day-to-day operations. This will include low volumes of general office waste, redundant metal and plastic componentry, wiring and circuitry.

Where possible, waste sent to landfill will be reduced to an absolute minimum. General office waste, metal and plastic componentry will be recycled utilising the estates existing collection services. We estimate that 90% of waste will be diverted from landfill.

On occasion, there may be small amounts of transmitter specific waste. Any redundant wiring or circuitry will be collected separately in line with WEEE regulations on a periodic basis. There may also be a periodic requirement for secure paper document waste collection. This will be via a secure third-party provider.

All waste will be kept in small to medium bins inside the building areas and manually transported to the larger estate central waste bins on a weekly / as required basis.
