Our previous comments on the inappropriateness of the urban design of the gates and railings, also apply to this application. This is a rural village-edge area where the topography and historic development of the estates at Northaw and Nyn Park have given rise to a landscape of designed views but with an emphasis on the natural over the formal. Well Road is a rural thoroughfare and should be respected as such. Suburban boundary designs of the type illustrated in this application are irrelevant to this situation. We would welcome a more sympathetic boundary treatment, in keeping with the historic and rural nature of the area"/>
