<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Thank you for consulting the Gardens Trust. Hertfordshire Gardens Trust is disappointed that there is no mention of the historical importance of the landscape. Bedwell Park, Essendon Place, Camfield Place and Bird's Hill are all early designed landscapes which cluster together in this part of Essendon. We would expect some consideration of the fact that the woodlands where the proposal is sited were historically part of the Bedwell Park perimeter belt. We are aware that much of the significance of Bedwell Park has been lost due to development and the laying out of the golf course. For that reason we do not raise any objections to the proposed development provided sufficient screening remains between the proposed houses and Bedwell Park."/>
