Comments	<input type="text" value="Attn: William Myers (Case Officer) I spoke this morning with the manager of Hook Lake, which is not far from the site of the demolished Hook Cottages. He remembers the cottages standing in a derelict state in the late 80s/early 90s. He was also able to state that the historic dog-fighting case (arranged at the time by customers of the nearby Chequers Public House) took place in this derelict building. Research into the case online has proven difficult, but an Independent newspaper report of 2002 dates the dog-fighting (eleven convicted) as taking place in 1985. This is further evidence that the buildings were not 'fully demolished' in 1975."/>
