<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Thank you for consulting the Gardens Trust, of which Hertfordshire Gardens Trust is a member. Well Road is largely rural in character with hedges lining the road. From the information supplied with this application we are unable to determine the species the relocated hedges would be nor their height. The railings and gates as illustrated would seem to be more urban in design than appropriate for this location and would impact on views along the B156 coming from Northaw, to the detriment of the approach to Northaw House, a park and garden considered by HGT to be of Local Historic Significance. We would suggest more modest railings and gates in keeping both with the rural nature of the area and the nearby Northaw House, whose estate railings are of the type appropriate for this location."/>
