Thank you for your application requesting the discharge of the above condition.

The submitted archaeological Written Scheme of Investigate (WSI) does not provide sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of this condition. Moreover, it is recognised that this condition has been breached by reason that planning permission 6/2017/2342/FULL has commenced prior to the WSI being approved by the Local Planning Authority. As such, this condition cannot be formally discharged.

Section 171A(1)(b) states that "failing to comply with any condition or limitation subject to which planning permission has been granted, constitutes a breach of planning control". Accordingly, the Council's Planning Enforcement Department have been notified.
