Main Issues					
Appropriateness of the works in relation to the tree(s)	4 of the 6 trees are situated within the boundary of number 12 Stanborough Close. Trees are situated to the rear of the property and form a small group with the 2 trees situated within 11 Stanborough Close. These trees are approximately 11m in height with a 3m crown spread. Trees have been maintained as pollards and appear to be in good health. Trees are visible from all public spaces due to the height of the dwellings and breaks between surrounding properties. The trees offer a suitable soft landscaping feature for the area and are ideal for maintaining as high pollards to continue adding character to the surrounding area. Proposed works were inappropriate and justification is insufficient to remove				

the trees.

Conclusion

The application proposal is not appropriate and would result in the loss of landscaping that would harm the character of the landscape.

Reasons for Refusal:

1. The work request is inappropriate and would result in the loss of landscaping that would harm the character and amenities of the area; contrary to Policy EM3 (Soft Landscaping) of the Welwyn Garden City Estate Management Scheme.
