| tree(s) | The tree is in excess of 10m tall and growing within a large grassed area adjacent to the carpark area. At the time of my visit the tree was showing signs of decline. Dead was noted throughout the crown and peeling bark was noted on the main stem. Also noted were old fungal fruiting bodies which would indicate decay fungi colonisation. | | | | |

The applicant is proposing to reduce the tree and by 30% and reduce a large limb significantly. Given the poor condition of the tree the prosed work is considered appropriate. The work will reduce the weight in the crown reducing the likelihood of failure.

Conclusion

The proposed tree works are proportionate to the health or structural issue of the tree displays and are reasonable arboricultural management will not harm the amenity of the individual trees or the woodland as a whole.

Conditions:

1. The works hereby approved shall be undertaken in accordance with the British Standard 3998:2010 (Tree Work) and by an appropriately qualified person.
