### The main issues are:

Whether the proposed works are permitted development by virtue of Schedule 2, Part 1, Class A of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 as amended.

#### Discussion

On section 4 of the application form, the applicant stated that the development had not started at the time of the application. However, the planning officer noted during a site visit carried out on 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2019 that the single storey rear extension had been fully completed.

Where an application is submitted under section 192 (proposed), but at the time the

application was made the development had been substantially completed, then the applicant should resubmit the application under section 191 (existing).

# Conclusion

For the reasons given above, the application for Certificate of lawfulness is therefore refused and the applicant is invited to resubmit this application under section 191 (existing).
