Main Issues					
Appropriateness of the works in relation to the tree(s)	<ul> <li>A subsidence issue has occurred and the Oak trees have been indicated as the cause. Sufficient evidence has been provided to indicate the Oak trees are causing the issue. Evidence supplied includes: <ul> <li>Level and crack monitoring – displaying seasonal movement of levels and cracks on the building to show the movement in the cracks and levels is reflective of subsidence caused by vegetation.</li> <li>Arboricultural report – identifying trees causing the issue.</li> <li>Site investigation factual report/Geotechnical report - inclusive of soil analysis (shear strength, moisture content, shear vane strength etc.), bore pits and root sample analysis.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Unfortunately this area is characterised by clay soils which have the ability to shrink and swell. The mature vegetation in the area has the possibility to exacerbate the issue of shrinking and swelling, causing vegetation caused subsidence. This occurs where the continued desiccation of the soil by the tree occurs to an extent that the soil is unable to recover, causing the building or in this instance, the house, to sink.</li> </ul> A neighbour has objected to the removal of the oaks, however the evidence provided is sufficient to implicate the trees in damage to the property. A refusal of the application could mean the council become liable for expensive repairs or underpinning				
at 10 Hook Lane, No	led indicates Oaks T4 and T5 to be the cause of the subsidence issue occurring orthaw, Potters Bar. Unfortunately this means the removal of these protected o protect the property.
