	There were not many low branches at the time of the site visit but there was some thinner bits of epicormic along with vegetation not subject to a TPO that would obstruct visibility. While the oak has minimal disruption to the visibility of exiting the driveway, a crown lift would not detract from the amenity the tree provides and would make it safer for all parties by having a sufficient lift.
