In reply to recent proposal, we feel it does not resolve the problem what so ever. Viewing from our side of 8 Orchard close the building from ridge to ground is approx 7 metres high and still to close to our boundary.

The suggestion to reduce height by a fraction has no impact to the problem and to plant conifers in such a minimal space between building and our boundary will only cause further problems. In maturity the conifers would cause problems to existing fence continually and can only be maintained by our side , that would mean having to access our garden. We feel, Mr Vassilou has taken upon himself to go conclusion to this, we can only see one clear option and that is to demolish building and building to be built in original position.

We conclude the building is overdeveloped, overlooking and overshadowing to my home and neighbouring properties.
