Note: Deciduous species to be planted between late October/late March, evergreen or conifer species Sept/Oct or April/May, herbaceous plants in Sept/Oct or March/April and container grown plants at any time if ground and weather conditions are favourable. Plant handling to conform to HTA 'Handling and establishing landscape plants'. All plants to be protected from frost and handled with care, protected from mechanical damage and not subject to shock.

Note: Shrubs for hedges to be consistent in species, cultivar and clone to ensure a uniform hedge.
 Planting in trenches large enough to take full spread of roots. Set out plants evenly at 450mm centres in a staggered row 400mm between lines.
 Shrub mixes to be planted in groups of the same species, avoiding straight lines.

4. Patio, path and steps in Reconstituted Stone laid on min. 150mm hardcore and mortar base. Leave gaps for drainage. Stone to be laid to gradual fall away from building. Edges in brick where shown. Brick to be frost resistant and laid on hardcore/mortar base as noted above, provide sample of stone and brick for Client/Architect approval.

Sub-Base: 100mm thick Dtp type 1 granular material, laid and compacted in 100mm thick layers on min. 150mm thick 6F2 hardcore
