Dear Sirs

I was very disappointed to hear that a certificate of lawfulness has been applied for to erect three cottages on the land opposite my house, 4 Hook Lane.

I have spoken to colleagues whose families worked at the kennels in the 1960s and there is no recollection of homes on the site, there was only a shed. However there were two cottages down the bridleway leading to isolation unit, These were demolished in the mid-1990s [REDACTED], definitely not in the 1970s as suggested.

We have early film footage of the Lane and there is no evidence of any houses on the land opposite my house.

[REDACTED] in January 1987, there was a water tower and artesian well which was removed later that year.

Hook Lane is unique, the Lane is a bridle way and used daily by horses, it cannot handle any more traffic. The lane is very narrow and two cars pass with difficulty. The Lane certainly can't take cars being parked on the road as the emergency services wouldn't be able to get through.

Please take these comments into consideration.
