

I have sent a more general enquiry to the General e-mail address for the Council, so I apologise if you get this twice.

Some work is going on at a house on our street, which is taking up quite a lot of the street. However, the point I would like to make, is firstly that on the planning database on your website it seems that the consultation period only began last week, so I was wondering why the work has been going on for at least 3 weeks already? And secondly, on the list of neighbours that received letters about the application, the whole street is listed apart from us!

While I have no fundamental objections to whatever is is they are doing, it would have been good to have had a letter about the application and for the letter to have been sent out before work commenced. Our street has been blocked up by skips and vans for the best part of a month, making the parking situation worse than it usually is.

The application in question (as far as I can see) is S6/2010/0094/LB and relates to 7 Fore Street, Hatfield. (Although there are two earlier planning applications also relating to their roof-S6/2008/0014/LB and S6/2008/0017/FP, which we didn't receive a letter about either).
