I am writing to object about the proposed building of 38 dwellings at Colesdale Farm at the junction of Northaw Roads West and East, and Cattlegate Road in Cuffley/Northaw for the following reasons:

- This would be an "island development" and against National Planning Policy.
- This would not constitute very special circumstances for building on Green Belt.
- There is insufficient infrastructure to warrant increasing the population. Insufficient schools, roads (roads would become busier and the village would become noisier). It is already at a bottleneck where the proposal is being made which would create even more traffic. Cars would be the only means of reaching Cuffley/Crews Hill as it would be too far and dangerous to walk - and besides there are no pavements!
