Subject to the informatives the highway authority would not wish to restrict the grant of planning permission. I recommend inclusion of the following advisory note to ensure that the works within the highway are carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Act 1980. AN1) Parking and Storage of materials: The applicant is advised that all areas for parking, storage, and delivery of materials associated with the construction of this development should be provided within the site on land which is not public highway, and the use of such areas must not interfere with the public highway. If this development is likely to result in the public highway or public right of way network becoming routinely blocked (fully or partly) the applicant must contact the Highway Authority to obtain their permission and requirements before construction works commence. The proposals are for the installation of 1x fascia board and replacement of canopy Comment The site is situated on Maynard Place which is designated classified and provides a secondary distributor function within the road hierarchy. It is subject to a 30 mph speed limit and maintainable at public expense. A review of accidents (5 years rolling

to date) identifies several recorded accidents in the near vicinity. However, there is no reason to consider that the reported accidents are associated with the applicant site The proposals are for external alterations to provide new fascia board and replacement of canopy. The site access is mainly from a pedestrianised frontage. Its important to note the informatives above especially where works are in or over the footpath. The proposals are not considered to result in any adverse impact on the public highway or be of any disturbance to drivers therefore, subject to the informatives are considered acceptable to the Highway Authority.
