I was advised to contact you in regard to the above application which has been approved . I would like to appeal against the decision as the plans which have been approved still show an un-neighbourly amount of clear glass in the proposed build in the house immediately adjacent to our property.

The eastern elevation of house 1 which overlooks our property shows only some of the windows obscured. The very large square of glass ,elevated in the stairwell is shown as unobscured. Although the planning condition states that the glass should be obscured, the diagram of house1 shows it as unobscured.

The point for us is that we have a large conservatory with a clear glass roof which will be significantly overlooked by this structure. We spend much of our time in this conservatory.

We, like your good selves , are concerned about unneighbourliness and such a structure would represent that for us .

We do not seek a complete revamp of this application and we are aware that it has now been approved. We simply want to make sure that everyone is clear that any window area on a side elevation is not made with clear glass.

We do not think that this is unreasonable.

Please let us know what additional steps we need to take to ensure that house 1 meets this requirement .
