

The addition of the extensions to the rear and side comply with Class A.3 (a) The materials to be used are similar to those used on the existing dwelling (b) There are no upper floor windows included to side elevations (c) The cool pitch of the emission dwelling materials and the existing dwelling materials that of the existing dwelling materials and the existing dwelling materials.

In such cases the roof of the extension should not be considered as protrivingly from the original roof of the original roots.
