COMMENTS

The proposals are for the Removal and replacement of 6no antennas. Internal upgrade of existing equipment room and associated ancillary works. The site for the works appears to be on the roof of the Galleria Multi Storey Car Park level 7, as such, the proposals are unlikely to have any impact on the surrounding highway network. This would include maintenance and servicing of the equipment.
