Church. 1881, by C Kirk and Son of Sleaford. Replacing church of 1809.

The church has an exceptional painted interior.

In the south chapel, the decorative scheme is being continuously harmed by the abutment of the cover slab of the redundant external boiler room. It is understood that the parish have renewed the decorations in this area several times previously.





There proposals are to remove the cover slab, back fill the boiler room and reinstate the churchyard.
