Thank you for consulting Hertfordshire Ecology on this application.

The Hertfordshire Environmental Records Centre does not have any species or habitat data for the application site, which includes demolition of the existing external pool and outbuilding structures and removal of paving.

The pool building appears to be relatively recent and consequently sub-optimal for bats to use for roosting. Due to the nature and scale of the proposals, I do not consider that any ecological surveys are necessary in this instance. The application can be determined accordingly.
