With reference to the planning application for the retirement homes, I object most strongly and would hope that it is turned down by the council.

We have an exceptional amount of new building going on in the area, with Cuffley and Goffs Oak multi building projects, the area will be swamped with Hundreds of additional people.

Already the area around this proposed site is subject to long delays due to traffic congestion.

The site has limited accessibility other than by private transport, making the situation even worse than it is now.

Local medical services, which have their own problems at the moment would suffer with the extra demand.

Barnet Hospital, which I had to attend recently cannot cope with the amount of people visiting A & E. I waited four Hours to see a doctor, this is surely unacceptable.
