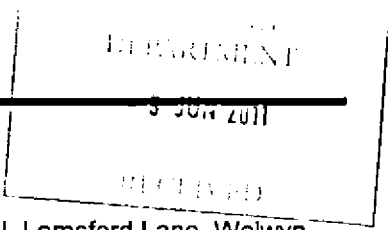

**EXTENSION TO EXISTING CLASSROOMS AND ALTERATIONS TO EXTERNAL PLAY AREA –  
LAKESIDE SCHOOL, LEMS福德 LANE, WELWYN GARDEN CITY**

Thank you for consulting Sport England on the above planning application. As the proposal does not affect a playing field of at least 0.2 hectares in size, the consultation is not statutory under the terms of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) Order 2010 (SI No. 2184 (2010)).

The development would involve an extension to the existing classrooms and leveling and raising of the external play area. While I have not visited the site, the development would not appear to affect any playing fields or other formal sports facilities. The external play area at the rear of the site would not be considered as a sports facility. As the development would not appear to have any adverse affect on formal sports facility provision on the school site, I can therefore confirm that Sport England has no objection to this planning application as a non-statutory consultee.
