We live at 70 Pine Grove which directly faces the access road to Chancellors School and have been greatly affected by the increase in traffic over the past 20 years as more pupils have brought cars to school and have parked them all along Pine Grove narrowing the road so that only one car can travel in one direction at the same time. While parking restrictions have been put in place around the entrance road, this has had limited success as there is no real enforcement of these restrictions. We believe that controlled parking for residents only and no parking between the hours of 12pm and 2pm for all non-residents would leave Pine Grove clear of all student cars currently parked during school times and also apply this to all surrounding roads in Brookmans Park. This would then allow buses and coaches to move freely on Pine Grove to pick up and drop off students. This would also help with the flow of parents cars dropping off their children by relieving bottlenecks at the turning into the school road as well as reducing potential accidents.

The plan to expand the school to take up to 200 more students will only serve to greatly aggravate this traffic and parking nightmare on Pine Grove together with an increased negative environmental impact on the village and its residents. We therefore object to further expansion of the school without providing a comprehensive solution to the points outline above.
