During the morning, afternoon and for that matter whenever there is an event at the school the congestion in Pine Grove is horrendous. Not only does it cause a hazard but is dangerous. An increase in the flow of traffic will add to this hazard. Already parking by parents at these times is inconsiderate and at the very least causes a nuisance.
