Comments	<input type="text" value="I object because of the abject failure of Wel/Hat Council to honour its obligations to the public to setup the Ellenbrook Park Trust, extract the indexed 106 money (now about £2.4million) from Arlington and develop the western part of the old airfield as a green space for public benefit. The proposed plans for 1100 houses etc and gravel pit will leave no green leisure space between Wel/ Hat and St. Albans and the additional density of traffic cannot be supported by local roads. We have been informed that Affinity Water is still monitoring the Bromate flume, and disturbance of this land/flume could contaminate drinking water. I can accept that more AFFORDABLE housing is needed, but this land is NOT the place for it. We hear that green spaces are important to mental health; take note of that, get the money out of Arlington, setup the EP Trust and allow the public to use this green space for their leisure as was intended in 1999.
