

This HAT2 proposal by Arlington breaches their original promise and s106 agreement signed in December 2000, providing 400 acres of Ellenbrook Park to the people of Hatfield. This was alongside the thousands of new houses being built in Salisbury and Hatfield Garden Villages, the old BA site.

The current HAT2 proposal would deprive residents of 200 acres of the park. Brett, plan to quarry the other 200 acres -so hardly any of the Park would be left if this development goes ahead. Ellenbrook fields are used by many residents each Saturday for the Park run, dog walking and it is a great green space for public exercise for Salisbury villagers, and Ellenbrook residents. Arlington have failed to form the Ellenbrook Park preservation trust (EPPT) in 18 years. Councillors and residents have recently met to take action to ask WHBC to require Arlington to complete the s106 agreement and facilitate the formation of the EPPT. Many residents in Hatfield are opposed to this development, which adds insult to injury. There is not sufficient road structure to support the increase in cars and traffic that would result from this new housing.
